ACHIEVEMENT QUALIFICATIONS

- Be in good standing with Kiwanis International and the district.
- Be at least at charter strength in membership.
- Earn 100 points from the following achievement opportunities:

1. MEMBERSHIP AND ENGAGEMENT

1.1	Develop a 2025-26 membership plan that includes: • At least one recruitment event. • Defined goals for each recruitment effort. <i>Kiwanis International provides an online form for a membership plan, to be submitted to the lieutenant governor.</i>	15 points
1.2	Recruit at least four (4) new members into the club.	15 points
1.3	Achieve a net gain of at least two (2) members.	10 points
1.4	Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Kiwanis club.	10 points
1.5	Appoint a club membership chairperson at the start of the administrative year. <i>Membership chairperson should be submitted on the club election report.</i>	5 points

2.1	Club president, secretary, treasurer and membership chairperson participate in Club Leadership Education or similar training coordinated by division, district or international educational leaders.	15 points
2.2	Officers are reported on the secretary dashboard.	10 points
2.3	At least one member attends the Kiwanis International convention.	5 points
2.4	At least one member participates in Kiwanis Amplify.	5 points

3.1	Submission of a club signature project in the Kiwanis Signature Project Contest.	5 points
3.2	Sponsorship of one or more of the following Service Leadership Programs: Aktion Club, Builders Club, Circle K International, Key Club or K-Kids.	15 points
3.3	Submit at least 10 of the 12 monthly club reports.	10 points

ACHIEVEMENT QUALIFICATIONS

- At least 80% of clubs in the division submit a membership plan with identified recruitment efforts and goals by December 31.
- At least 66% of the clubs in the division achieve distinguished club status.

Distinguished district recognition

ACHIEVEMENT QUALIFICATIONS

- At least 50% of the clubs in the district achieving distinguished club status.
- District must submit a membership plan by October 31.
- Establish one (1) Kiwanis Voices club within districts of 4,000 or fewer members; or two (2) Kiwanis Voices clubs within districts of more than 4,000 members.
- Open one (1) Circle K International club within districts of 4,000 or fewer members; or two (2) Circle K International clubs within districts of more than 4,000 members.
 - *In Europe and Asia Pacific regions in districts where Circle K International Clubs are not feasible, additional Kiwanis Voices club must be established (one (1) in districts of 4,000 or fewer and two (2) in districts of more than 4,000).*

— OR —

- 3% net increase in district membership.
- Meet the club opening goal established jointly between the president-elect and the governor-elect prior to the start of the administrative year. ***Clubs opened one month prior (September) and one month following (November) the administrative year count toward distinguished criteria.***
- Establish one (1) Kiwanis Voices club within districts of 4,000 or fewer members; or two (2) Kiwanis Voices clubs within districts of more than 4,000 members.
- Open one (1) Circle K International club within districts of 4,000 or fewer members; or two (2) Circle K International clubs within districts of more than 4,000 members.
 - *In Europe and Asia Pacific regions in districts where Circle K International Clubs are not feasible, additional Kiwanis Voices club must be established (one (1) in districts of 4,000 or fewer and two (2) in districts of more than 4,000).*

- Special qualitative assessment by president and/or board counselor
- Districts that achieve the higher new club opening goal would receive a special citation
